Cristina Barrocas Dias was awarded a PhD in Chemistry in 1999, and got her Habilitation in Chemistry in 2015. She is Professor in the Chemistry Department of Évora University and is currently deputy-director of the HERCULES Laboratory (<http://hercules.uevora.pt/>).

Her research expertise is in the area of the analysis of organic compounds by hyphenated chromatographic methods (LC-MS and GC-MS). She is author of 55 articles in peer reviewed journals and wrote 8 chapters in books. She was advisor of 6 PosDoc grants, 5 PhD theses and 25 master theses.
